



Wind Up - Rules of Play

(Coloniale Golf Club)

The 2022 Wind-Up Rules of Play apply using a Straight Time format - Texas Scramble format.

Eligibility

Players must be a NASA Golf Tour member to qualify for registration in the Wind Up.

Players must arrive at the tournament **no earlier than 1 hour before their tee time.**

Teams

Foursomes each player must hit **four** tee shots

Threesomes

- Each player must hit **five** tee shots
- First player named on the score card will hit two balls on the first hole
- Second player named on the score card will hit two balls on the second hole
- Third player named on the score card will hit two balls on the third hole
- Player whose tee shot is used will hit two second shots
- This rotation will continue the entire 18 holes
- *Once on the green the player hitting two balls will putt twice.*

Captain

The first name on the score card is responsible for the team score and score card.

Record scores on inside score line of card you were given. **And nothing else, or DQ**

Drive used: put the hole number adjacent the player's name in the space provided on the outside of the card. **Anywhere else is a DQ**

Any differences; the Captains word is final.

Captain gives score card to the Registration Desk at the conclusion of play.

Play

Tee boxes: **White** and for those members eligible to play **forward Silver**.

Hole-In-One Tee Boxes: All players hit from the White.

Do not spend more than **three** minutes looking for a lost ball.

No Mulligans.

The only prize holes are the **\$10,000 hole-in-one competitions at holes 3, 8, 11.**

An Official-in-Charge will be stationed at each these holes. If no hole-in-one is achieved, then a consolation prize will be given to the player closest to the hole.

Breaking Ties: Stroke Play Appendix 1 page 144 paragraph (c)

There are no Gimmies.

Meal Service

Meal tickets will be issued when you arrive and register for the Wind Up.

Green ticket: Before golf tee off meal

Yellow ticket: After golf meal (maximum stay 1 ½ hours)
